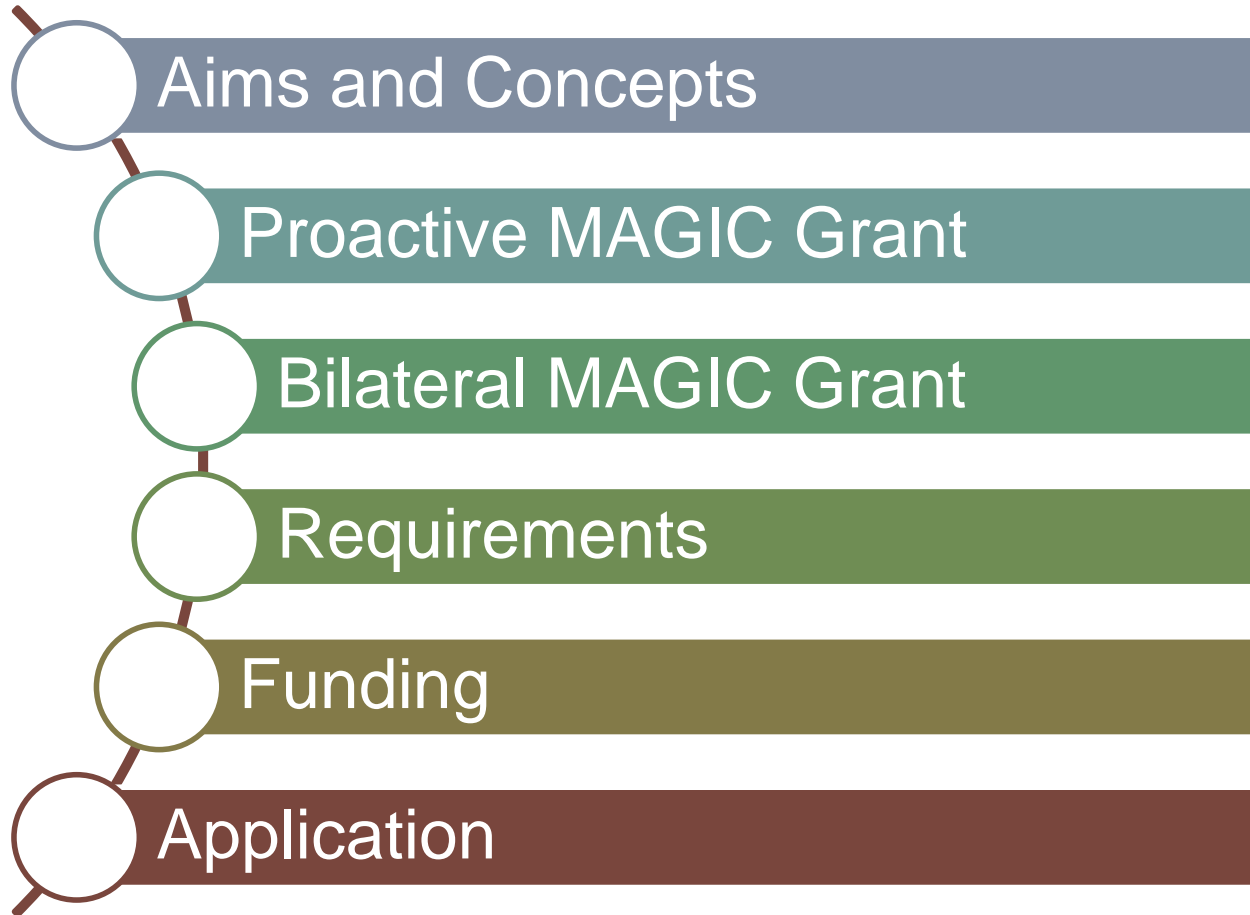

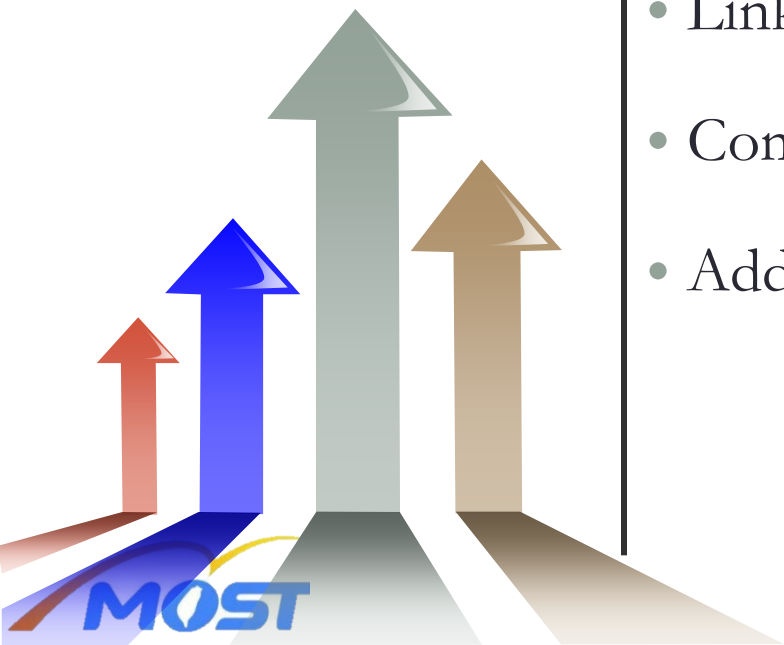


# Main Concepts

Upgrade scientific  
research in Taiwan

by international standard

- Leverage research capabilities of 20,000 MOST research projects
- Select excellent PIs for Int'l cooperation
- Link new int'l teams and outstanding labs
- Combine multiple sources of funding
- Add on grant for Int'l cooperation





# MOST Add-on Grant for International Cooperation

## Aims and principles

- Encourage outstanding PIs to extend their projects internationality
- Bring together resources to expand bases for more opportunities
- Keep bilateral commitments
- **Requirement: PIs with ongoing projects**





# Proactive MAGIC Grant

- Open to all research areas
- Submit a proposal at least 3 months prior to its implementation
- Eligible applicants
  - Principal Investigators of on-going research projects funded by the MOST
- Eligible partners
  - Full-time scholars or researchers in foreign universities, colleges, and research institutions
  - Not including China, Hong-Kong and Macao
- Duration
  - No longer than the duration of original on-going projects

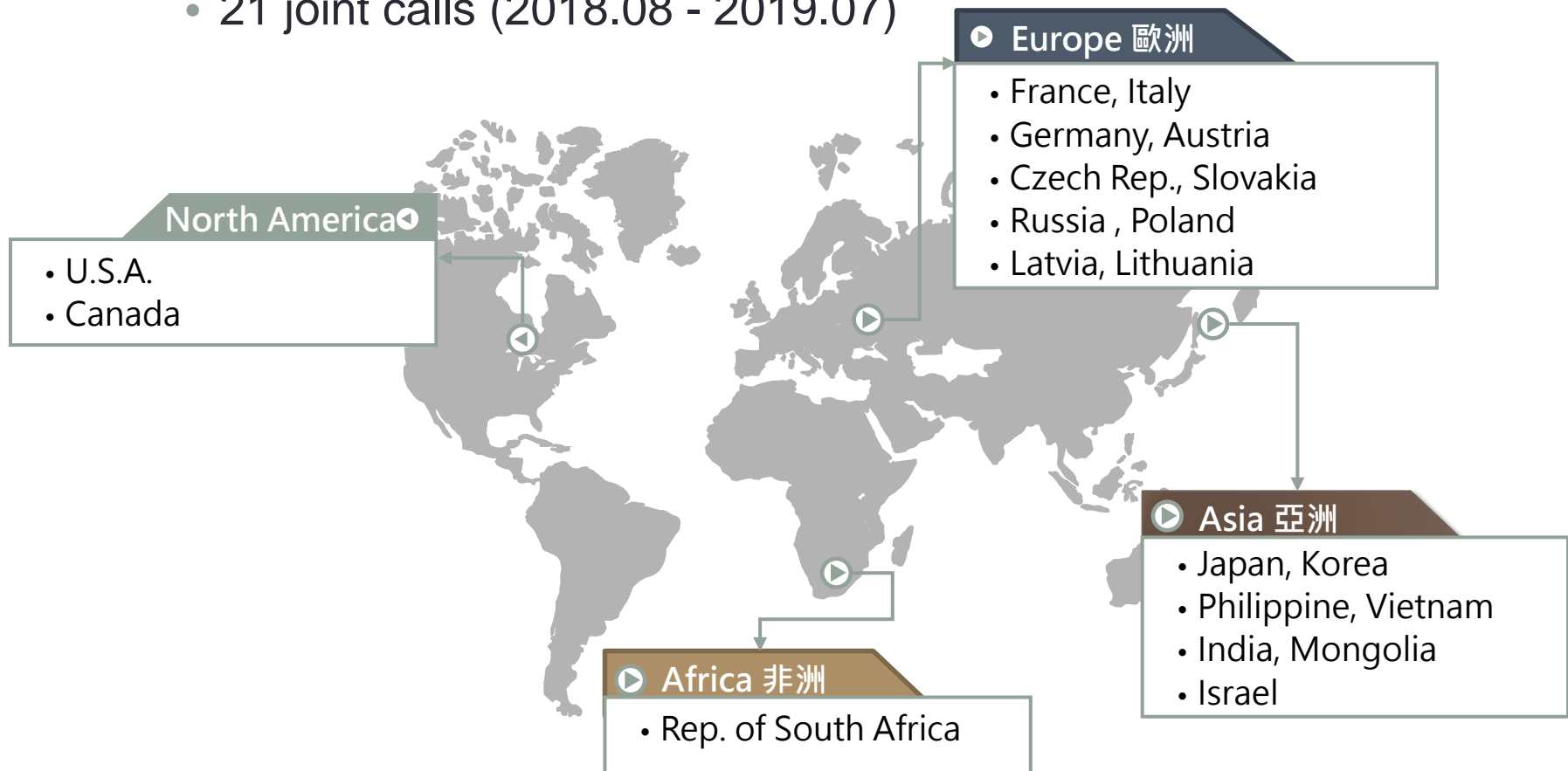


# Bilateral MAGIC Grant

- Follow joint calls for proposals with partner organizations
- Submit a proposal before deadlines announced in the joint calls
- Eligible applicants
  - PIs of on-going research projects funded by the MOST
- Eligible partners
  - As specified in bilateral agreements
- Duration
  - As specified in bilateral agreements, normally 2 years or 3 years

# Bilateral / Trilateral cooperative countries

- Joint calls for research proposals
  - 20 countries
  - 21 joint calls (2018.08 - 2019.07)





# Funding

- Proactive MAGIC
  - Expenses for international cooperation
    - General research expenses
    - Overseas travel expenses
    - Allowance for PIs
  - Up to 50% budget of the original on-going project
- Bilateral MAGIC
  - Expenses for international cooperation
    - General research expenses
    - Overseas travel expenses
    - Research equipment fee
    - Allowance for PIs

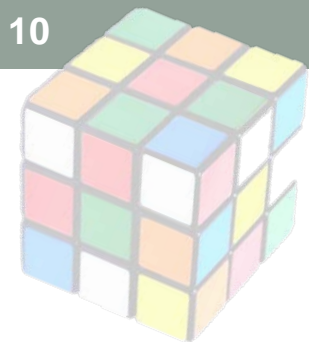




# Application

- Submit required documents online at the MOST webpage through “Academic Research Service Portal “
